



A zamara was launched by Royal Caribbean Group in 2007 and was positioned as a deluxe brand, between the premium and luxury segments of the market. It was later rebranded as an up-market, destination-immersion driven experience.

Originally launched under the Celebrity Cruises' umbrella, Azamara was soon moved out as a separate brand and product identity, and with a dedicated staff.

Azamara started with two ships, the Azamara Journey and Quest, which were transferred from sister company Pullmantur Cruises. A third vessel, the Azamara Pursuit, was acquired from P&O Cruises, and started service in August 2018.

In 2021, Royal Caribbean Group sold the company to Sycamore Partners, a private equity firm, which also acquired a fourth ship, the Azamara Onward.
